

TRIBAL BROADBAND CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND UPDATE

- Tribal Broadband Connectivity Program (TBCP) established with ~\$1B from the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021
- National telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) received 301 applications, totaling more than \$5.88B for initial NOFO.
- The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law provided \$2B in additional funding to TBCP
- NTIA has allocated \$1B of this added funding for existing applications. The remaining funds are allocated to a second NOFO to be released in 2023.
- To date, the program has made 132 awards totaling more than \$1.7B.
