		The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC benefit program, which replaced and builds upon the FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit Program, to help ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare, and more.
4	Program Overview	The benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase price.
		The Affordable Connectivity Program benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.
