<b>Program Overview</b>	EDA's PW and EAA programs provide economically distressed communities and regions with comprehensive and flexible resources to address a wide variety of economic development needs. Specifically, PW supports the construction, expansion or upgrade of public infrastructure and facilities. EAA flexibly supports the development and/or implementation of strategies to assist communities or regions that have experienced or are under the threat of serious damage to their underlying economic base. Projects funded by these programs will, among other things, leading to the creation and retention of jobs and increased private investment, advance innovation, enhance the manufacturing capacities of regions, provide workforce development opportunities and growing ecosystems that attract foreign direct investment. Through these programs, EDA supports bottom-up strategies that build on regional assets to spur economic growth and resiliency.
